AAS GRADUATION PARADES

Notes

- 1. The 3rd and 5th Intakes, (or Classes) respectively, graduated in mid-1952 and mid-1953, whereas all other graduations occurred in December of each year. This excludes "A (or 0.5) Intake/Class" Musicians who also graduated mid-year (2-year course). "A" (mid-year) Intake Clerks (6-month course) graduated in December each year.
- 2. The 6th was the last (except for Musicians and 10th Clerks) recruited at 6-monthly intervals.
- 3. Until January 1955, the Army School of Music remained separate from the AAS. At this time, Apprentice Musicians were considered part of the AAS and graduations from December 1956 included Apprentice Musicians.
- 4. From December 1979, 3rd Year Electronics Tradesmen (ETs) either "graduated" early with their intake/class and then remained at the School until they had completed their training, or they left before their graduation and returned at the end of that year for graduation with the intake/class after them. Third year ETs were allocated to the Senior Apprentice Company (SAC). This practice ceased in 1987 with the graduation of the 40th Intake.
- 5. The December 1972 graduation (with the 25th and 26th Intakes) was the first where the traditional training system of three years at the AAS then one year in a workshop (3 + 1) was replaced with a 2 years + 2 years system (except for ETs which remained at 3 years + 1 year). From that time, Musicians who joined at the beginning of each year graduated from Balcombe at the same time as the other trades in that Intake.
- 6. The Army School of Music moved to Simpson Barracks, Victoria when the AAS moved to Bonegilla, Victoria in 1982/83, meaning that the 36th Intake of Musicians was the last who graduated from the AAS at Balcombe.


